The City of Odessa Community Development Department receives two grants annually from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD): Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME). The primary objective of these programs is to develop viable communities, by providing decent housing, a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities for persons of low and moderate income.

In an effort to prepare the Five-Year 2010-2014 Consolidated Plan and the One-Year 2010-2011 Action Plan, the **2010-2014 Consolidated Plan Survey** is now available directly on the City of Odessa's home website. The Community Development Department is requesting citizen input on two separate topics for two vital purposes:

- 1) To identify the needs of our community and develop five-year goals and strategies to address these needs.
- 2) Complete an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing within the community.

It is important that citizens and organizations participate in this survey process to assist the City of Odessa in identifying the needs within the community. Please let us know where these funds should be allocated.
