Every year the City Community Development Department receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) funds from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). These funds are used primarily to develop viable communities for persons of low and moderate income.

Citizens and community organizations are encouraged to participate in an online survey to help identify those needs in our community, as well as develop five year goals and strategies to address those needs.

- 2) Complete an analysis of impediments to fair housing within the community.
