POLICE RECRUIT INTERN

Entry-level position for non-certified Police Officer applicants who have not attained the age of 20 years. Receives mandatory orientation and training. May be assigned to various department operations until entry into the Odessa Police Academy. A successful Police Recruit Intern is eligible for the first Odessa Police Academy during which time the Intern will attain the age of 21 years by graduation from the Academy. The primary responsibility of an individual in this job category is to successfully complete the Odessa Police Academy in order to become a certified Police Officer. During employment as a Police Recruit Intern, the individual is required to take and successfully complete at least 6 hours of post secondary study per semester at a local college or university. Continued employment is contingent upon successful completion of the Academy and obtaining a passing score on the TCOLE Peace Officer written test.

Education:

Minimum of a high school diploma or G.E.D. certification.

Certification:

Must possess a Valid Texas Driver License.

Requirements:

Ability to read and write in English, and to understand and follow oral and written instructions in English. Must be a U.S. citizen. Ability to successfully complete the following application process: oral interview board, 1/2 mile run in 5 minutes or less, entry level test, agility test, TABE9 Reading Comprehension test, background investigation, polygraph, medical physical, drug screen, vision test and psychological examination.
