**SUBJECT:** CRIME IN ODESSA – 2012

### INTRODUCTION

Local law enforcement agencies regularly submit crime statistics to the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) system through their state law enforcement agencies. Part I UCR crimes are the eight "major" offenses and may be divided into violent and property crimes. The violent crimes include murder, rape, aggravated assault, and robbery. The property crimes include burglary (residential & business), larceny (theft & burglary of a vehicle), auto theft, and arson. Part II UCR crimes include all other offenses such as vandalism, DWI, disorderly conduct, drug offenses, weapons offenses, etc.

### 2012 STATISTICS

Odessa's crime rate was down in two of the eight Part I crime categories.

The **overall** Part I crime rate for 2012 **increased** by 24% as compared with 2011 (4842 vs 3907).

The **violent** crime rate for 2012 **increased** by 47% as compared with 2011 (1102 vs 749).

The **property** crime rate for 2012 **increased** by 18% as compared with 2011 (3740 vs 3158).



The **Part II** crime rate for 2012 **increased** by 4% as compared with 2011 (4435 vs 4282).
