



**CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
CITY OF ODESSA, TEXAS**

**NOVEMBER 7, 2017**

On November 7, 2017, a special meeting of the Odessa City Council was held at 5:00 p.m., at City Hall, Council Chambers, fifth floor, 411 W. 8<sup>th</sup> St., Odessa, Texas.

Council members present: Mayor David R. Turner; Council members: Malcolm Hamilton, District One; Dewey Bryant, District Two; Barbara Graff, District Three; Michael Gardner, District Four; and Filiberto Gonzales, District Five.

Others present: Larry Long, City Attorney; Norma Aguilar-Grimaldo, City Secretary; Michael Marrero, Interim City Manager; Konrad Hildebrandt, Assistant City Manager; other members of City staff; and members of the news media.

**PUBLIC HEARING**

**Open a public hearing to consider annexation to the City of Odessa of approximately 206.53 acres of land in Sections 35 (203.17 acres) and 26 (3.36 acres), Block 42, T-1-S T&P RR Co. Survey, Ector County; approximately 4.4 acres of land out of Section 4, Block 41, T-2-S, T&P R Y Co. Survey, Ector County; and approximately 0.416 acres of right-of-way (a 50' x 382.66' portion of Pacific Drive) in Section 18, Block 42, T-2-S, T. & P. R.R. Co. Survey, Ector County, Texas (Second Public Hearing).** Mr. Long stated that the State required two public hearings. He reviewed the three parcels of land to be annexed. Council member Graff asked if the access to the Faudree section was going to have proper safe access. Mr. Long stated that there would be safety on the access, which would be addressed during the platting phase. Council member Gonzales asked about the section on Pacific Drive. Mr. Long stated that it was a right-of-way improvement. Curb and gutter would be added if annexed but would remain as the same use. Any changes would need Council approval. The owners did not want the nearby streets and area annexed. No one came forward and the public hearing was closed.

There was no other business, the meeting adjourned at 5:09 p.m.
