The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 816437.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the report number 19-39834 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold report number 19-39834 under section 552.108(a)(1). However, you must release the basic information from report number 19-39834 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the remaining reports, we conclude you must withhold the remaining reports pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 261.201 of the Family Code.
