EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On March 27, 2020, Congress passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act or the "CARES Act". The Act identified additional funding for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program to support preparation for and response to the community impacts of the COVID19 pandemic.

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development allocated **\$514,553** in CDBG-CV funds to the City of Odessa.

The City Council voted to provide funding for projects that would best serve the community by supporting the preparation for and responding to the community impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.
